



Moments is a secure **‘award winning’** mobile app for capturing life’s treasured moments. It’s a place to store memories, thoughts, and essential information that users can share with loved ones privately and securely.

Moments is a multipurpose app, where users (or their companion) can use multimedia content (Audio, Images, Letters and Video) to convey anything they wish to share and is utilised for digital adult journaling.

Use Moments to set personal reminders or to easily express intentions as a complement to a will and estate plan. Moments can be used for storytelling, scrapbooking and even bringing a photo album to life with a voice.

Use the app to explain matters like the handling of belongings, and to pass along information about family traditions and history.

It is also utilised in dementia-based settings to share activity updates and for various research-based requirements to evidence best practice and to assist with recording health and wellbeing improvements.

### Designed with the future in mind

After cloud enables a user to save and share their personal stories in a digital memory vault. This can include photos, letters, voice and audio recordings and videos. For example:

- A video showing activity or best practice to stakeholders.
- Audio message for the user’s family, wishing them well.
- Share photos with memories of who is who audio explanations.
- A letter for a partner, including photos and videos you wish to share.
- A message to someone the user cares about, saying something that they have always wanted to say.



The ‘Companion’ user profile within Moments enables content to be shared by carers, doulas, nurses, practitioners, therapists or a trusted third party on behalf of an individual and to also demonstrate best practice and person centred care for life enrichment activities and life legacy work.

Also used for documenting and evidencing improvements in art, dance, music, memory care and reminiscence therapies.
